By 1987, now a very successful businessman, Dino created his masterpiece in South Hackensack, *Clemente’s Bakery*. Here, along with more than 25 employees, he manages and operates his warehouse production with the most sophisticated and automated equipment available.

In addition to his professional endeavors, Dino takes immense pride in his family. Married to Anna for 51 years, they are the proud parents of five: Vincenzo, Maddalena, Maria, Giulia, and Dino Jr. They are also the proud grandparents of five.
